The art of falconry became an increasingly popular part of country life in the 19*th* century. Wealthy landowners would enjoy flying falcons over their estates and catching edible game for the larder with their hawks. Join our Victorian Falconers and listen to nostalgic tales about birds and the adventures of their human companions. Marvel at a stunning collection of birds of prey as they take to the skies in a series of live flying demonstrations set against a traditional rural landscape.

Displays last for approximately 40 minutes and every flying display is different.
